# **Understanding Polarization, Part 1**

#### PBS: How US History could provide a path out of polarization. (6:38)

As you reflect on what you have heard, spend a few moments recalling your own story of division and polarization. Consider the following for 2-3 minutes in silence then share with a partner from your group:

How did you learn to identify with a particular group, political party or issue organization?

How has your consciousness shifted in the last 10 years?

What influences have shaped the shifts in your identify?

#### Practice for this week

#### Find a 20-30 minute block of time for this practice.

Choose an audio, television or video recording of a news source that you <u>trust</u>. Listen without interruption for 12 minutes. Identify words or phrases which strengthen polarization.

Next, choose an audio, television or video recording of a news source that you ordinarily <u>reject</u>. Listen without interruption for 12 minutes. Identify words or phrases which strengthen polarization.

Spend 3-5 minutes reflecting on your experience in light of the information from this gathering. Be prepared to share about your practice next week.
